



Gospel Chapel Reopening Plan – To Begin on May 24th, 2020



Phase One

Goal: To keep everyone safe who chooses to attend, and to allow everyone the choice.

- Strict Safe Distancing a Must
- Face masks (encouraged)
- Hand sanitizer stations available
- Only households may sit together
- Must be six feet between families
- Controlled entries and exits
- No communion on church grounds
- No greeting times
- No coffee or meals
- Sick must stay home
- Intense cleaning between services
- Restroom visits are discouraged
- Basement only used for overflow on Sundays
- Vulnerable will be given grace to stay home
- Live Stream will continue

Phase Two

Goal: To keep everyone safe and to allow more ministry programming.

- Moderate safe distancing
- Face masks (optional)
- Hand sanitizer stations available
- Brunch Bites Resume
- Safe communion resumes
- Greeting times optional
- Sick must still stay home
- Intense cleaning between services continues
- Sunday School offered (small classes)
- Restrooms open again
- Live Stream will continue
- “Vulnerable” still encouraged to stay home
- Church is available for small gatherings
- Continue social media connections

Phase Three

Goal: To move back to the new normal activity for the church.

- Remove safe distancing
- No facemasks
- Hand sanitizer still available
- Normal seating
- Regular communion
- Resume nursery and Sunday School
- Brunch Bites & church meals resume
- Sick stay home (common sense)
- Continue Live Stream
- Church available for large group use
- Encourage face-to-face connections
- Cleaning will go back to normal standards
